
Sir/Madam,

Notification

S.O. (E).-In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of section 77 read with section 169 of the Representation of the People Act, 1951 (43 of 1951), the Central Government, after consulting the Election Commission, hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Conduct of Elections Rules, 1961, namely:-

- (1) These rules may be called the Conduct of Elections (Amendment) Rules, 2014.
(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
- In the Conduct of Elections Rules, 1961, in rule 90, for the existing Table and entries relating thereto, the following Table and the entries shall be substituted, namely:-

(अ). —केन्द्रीय सरकार, लोक प्रतिनिधित्व अधिनियम, 1951 (1951 का 43) की धारा 169 के साथ पठित धारा 77 की उपधारा (3) द्वारा प्रदत्त शक्तियों का प्रयोग करते हुए, निर्वाचन आयोग से परामर्श करने के पश्चात्, निर्वाचनों का संचालन नियम, 1961 का और संशोधन करने के लिए निम्नलिखित नियम बनाती है, अर्थात् :---

(2) ये राजपत्र में प्रकाशन की तारीख को प्रवृत्त होंगे।


